



TERMS OF REFERENCE: PROPOSAL FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT CONSULTANT (PMC) FOR PROJECT ORIOLE

1. INTRODUCTION

The Terms of Reference ("TOR") outlines the steps and processes required of the proponent for the preparation of the **Proposal for Project Management Consultant ("PMC")**, Oriole Hydro Hulu Padas **162MW Plant Project** (hereinafter referred as "**Project**").

Oriole Hydro Padas Sdn. Bhd. (202101042306 (1442606-D)) (hereinafter referred as "**Employer**" and/or "**Oriole**"), intends to set up a run-of-river hydropower scheme along Sungai Padas in the state of Sabah which comprises two (2) hydropower plants as follows:

- (1) Padas 1 Hydropower Plant (55MW); and
- (2) Padas 2 Hydropower Plant (107MW).

To assist Oriole with the administration, implementation, monitoring, and supervision of the Project, Oriole requires a PMC with the relevant experience to provide comprehensive consulting services inclusive of engineering design review and consulting, project management, contract management, technical support services, and standing supervision of Engineering Procurement Construction Commissioning ("**EPCC**") works. The PMC shall be employed by Oriole for a duration of 42 months of construction period.

Employer is inviting for proposals from qualified consultancy firms for appointment as PMC for this Project. The PMC shall work directly for Employer, and it is the intent of Employer to enter into a contract for the above noted work with successful proponent. Instructions, decisions and directions, where necessary is to be obtained from the Employer who will provide oversight to the operations of the PMC. The PMC role is to ensure that the design, construction and commissioning of the Project are in full compliance with the project scope documents, commissioning protocol, applicable construction and safety practices, Sabah Grid Code, Energy Commission of Sabah requirement and Prudent Utility Practices.

This Terms of Reference ("TOR") shall be deemed to form part of the contract.

3. MINIMUM QUALIFICATION OF THE PMC

The minimum qualifications of the PMC include but are not limited to the following:

- a) The proponents, whether as a firm, a joint venture or team members, shall demonstrate proven capabilities and relevant experience involved in basic engineering, detailed engineering, contract management and project management in at least two (2) run-of river hydropower plants in Malaysia, which have been successfully executed and commissioned.
- b) The proponent must be registered with Board of Engineers Malaysia (BEM), under the relevant category. Documentary evidence of a current and valid BEM registration, including certified copy of BEM certificate shall be submitted as part of the RFP proposal.

It is beneficial if the proponent or team members has proven working experience with Sabah Electricity Sdn Bhd (SESB) for the past 3 years.

The scope of services for each reference plant(s) should include basic and detailed engineering design review, project management of the plant including associated civil, electromechanical, electrical, control and instrumentation, and construction management for set up of the plant.
