<p>1.0 The Purpose</p> <p>1.1 The purpose of this Green Purchasing Policy (henceforth: the Policy) is to support the Jentayu Sustainable Group (henceforth: JSB Group) sustainability goals by promoting the purchase of environmentally friendly products and services. This Policy aims to establish clear guidelines for green purchasing, encourage suppliers to provide eco-friendly products, and support the transition to a more sustainable supply chain.</p> <p>2.0 The Policy</p> <p>2.1 All purchasing decisions should consider the environmental impact of the product or service, including its production, transportation, use, and disposal.</p> <p>2.2 All suppliers should be encouraged to provide eco-friendly products and services and to disclose the environmental impact of their products and services.</p> <p>2.3 All packaging should be minimised, and eco-friendly options such as biodegradable or recyclable materials should be prioritised.</p> <p>2.4 All paper products should be made from recycled materials and be certified by a recognised environmental standard.</p> <p>2.5 All cleaning products should be eco-friendly, non-toxic, and biodegradable.</p> <p>2.6 All transportation and logistics should prioritise eco-friendly options, such as electric vehicles, hybrid vehicles, or public transportation.</p> <p>3.0 Implementation</p> <p>3.1 The Sustainability Working Group (henceforth: SWG) will oversee the implementation of this Policy and monitor progress towards our sustainability goals.</p> <p>3.2 A list of preferred suppliers who provide eco-friendly products and services will be maintained and shared with employees.</p> <p>3.3 All purchasing decisions will be reviewed by the SWG to ensure compliance with the Policy and relevant environmental standards.</p> <p>3.4 Regular communication and reminders will be sent to employees to reinforce the importance of this policy and encourage compliance.</p>
